Dykes on Bikes® Inc in Sydney was originally established to provide a safe space for same-sex attracted women to participate in motorcycling and community events.

Women have often been the marginalised, silenced or invisible part of the Gay and Lesbian community, and it's important that we have space where we can be loud and proud. Leading the Sydney Gay and Lesbian Mardi Gras Parade is one of the few spaces where women are highly visible.

Over the years our community has changed, and some of our members have changed how they identify as well. Nowadays, members of our community have more opportunities and support to explore their identity, which means simply identifying as a woman may not cover their gender experiences.

To be a Full or Non-Sydney (riding) member of Dykes on Bikes® Inc you must also:

- Identify as a dyke,

- Be attracted to the same
- Have a valid motorcycle licence
